- Review Job 38 and 39. Select an appropriate section for your life group. Read aloud that section. What question asked is most humbling, or inspiring of awe and wonder?
- 3. Which point from the message impacted you more:
  - a. Being part of God's creation is part of my and others identity
  - b. We were made in God's image, to emulate God's care for his Creation
- There were two traps that we might fall into: Falling into False Worship, and Apathy and Disregard for God's Creation
  - a. Which is a greater risk for you?How do you guard your heart and mind from this?
  - b. How do we encourage each other to avoid these sins?
  - c. How might you live a grace-filled life that contradicts these ideas?



- d. How do you live a life that contradicts these lies in our wider society? What cost might you need to pay?
- 5. The question is not so much *should* I care, but *how* will I treat the gift of God?

Share your thoughts, dreams and aspirations and then spend time commissioning each other in prayer for what God has placed on your hearts and minds.
